

## Victor Ludorum Rules 2011

1. The Victor Ludorum prize will be awarded to the club which has accrued the most points at the British Rowing Masters Championships.
2. In order to accrue points a club must win a medal in that event, i.e. gold medal if 2 or more crews are entered, silver medal if 4 or more crews enter, bronze medal if 8 or more crews enter.
3. The following points will be awarded for each medal won by each club in Championship events

4. The following points will be awarded for each medal won by each club in Intermediate 3 and Novice events

	Gold	Silver	Bronze
8+	16	8	4
4x/4-/4+	12	6	3
2x/2-	8	4	2
1x	4	2	1

5. Points will be doubled for events where 4, 5, 6 or 7 crews have entered.
6. Points will be tripled for events where 8 or more crews have entered.
7. Points for composite crews will be awarded pro rata to the number of rowing individuals in each crew at the time of the draw. **There will be no change for any subsequent substitutions.** For example in a Championship 4- event with three entries a winning X/Y composite with three rowers from club X and one from club Y will win 18 points for club X and 6 for club Y.
8. A provisional result will be announced at the end of the day's racing and the prize money will be posted to the winning club once the result is confirmed.
9. In the event of any dispute the decision of the Organising Committee is final.
