2. The Regatta is held under British Rowing Rules and the British Rowing Rules of Racing, and Row Safe, apply.
3. All competitors must comply with the rules of the Masters Championships.
4. All competitors must be members of British Rowing (or equivalent for non-BR competitors).
5. All British Rowing Racing Licences (or equivalent for non-BR competitors) will be checked on the day.
6. The Masters Handicap System will be used, where appropriate, as detailed in the 2011 British Rowing Almanack.

8. Silver medals will be awarded if there are 4 or more entries in an event, bronze medals if there are 8 or more entries.
